- ❖ **ASIAN INFLUENCE:** Tour both the garden and energy efficient home tucked away in the citrus groves! Awaiting you are a beautiful view of Indian Head Mountain, Eastern-inspired sculptures, frankincense and our native Elephant Tree, combined with Burma (kaffir) limes, baby boojums and Afghan pine.
- ❖ **NATURAL FEELING:** This garden of over 75 trees and thoughtful, immaculate, xeriscape landscaping surround the mission style home. Covered outdoor patios, murals, relaxing ambience, and Toro Peak framed in the welcoming, tiled entrance will make you want to stay.
- ❖ **WATERFALL GARDEN:** Sounds of flowing water and charming alcoves invite us in. Watch the fish in the pond or contemplate the birds in this tree-covered sanctuary. Meandering paths through the cactus garden and mosaic tile artwork in desert motifs personalize this unique garden.
- ❖ **PALM COLLECTION:** Enter into the oasis courtyard roofed in a colorful bougainvillea arbor, and then scout the palms—over 30 different kinds from all over the world, Madagascar to Europe, Asia to the Everglades. Choose your favorites that you may want to find in your own garden.
