If you've ever visited Borrego Springs, California, U.S., you know that it's a special place! This is thanks to a group of advocates working to protect and defend the night sky, the Borrego Springs Dark Sky Coalition.

The coalition worked to receive two International Dark Sky Designations in the area. First, in 2009, the Borrego Springs International Dark Sky Community designation, followed by the 650,000-acre Anza-Borrego Desert Dark Sky Park which was designated in 2018. Together, these two International Dark Sky Places make up the only "dark sky region" in California.

Residents, wildlife, and the many annual visitors who travel to Borrego Springs all enjoy the results of the coalition's efforts. And the group continues its work to protect night skies. They innovated a dark sky business certificate which brings attention to local businesses engaging in night sky protection. So far, the coalition has certified 25 businesses! They also supported county engineers in reducing the brightness of local streetlights by 50%!

Every traveler who visits the town of Borrego Springs learns about the shared mission to protect dark skies.

Because of the work of the Borrego Springs Dark Sky Coalition, the Borrego Springs natural nighttime environment is protected long into the future. None of this would have happened without your financial support of IDA's programs and operations.
